eConsult is now available for non-IEHP **Members**

Yes, it's true! All patients who require access to specialty care can now receive eConsult treatment recommendations by using the "Add New Patient" link.

Clinical Follow Up Worklist

When a PCP ends the dialog by choosing a close code from the drop down menu, the eConsult lands in the "Clinical Follow Up Worklist" where the clinic staff can manage non-referral patient specialty care.
