


# 36,000 eConsults

### eConsult Learning Collaborative






#### **Achieving Our Goals**

As more eConsults were submitted throughout the year, the number of patient cases providers were able to resolve in non face-to-face encounters also increased.

This promising trend indicates the power of enhanced provider to provider communication in order to deliver more efficient care to patients.





#### ARMC Primary Care Clinics Shine

By coordinating with specialist reviewers via eConsult, 213 primary care providers at 7 ARMC clinic sites succeeded in resolving **over 1,000 eConsults** without the need for an in-person specialistpatient visit.

All eConsult cases for Opthalmology and Maternal/Fetal Medicine services were settled by entirely virtual means. Neurology and Pulmonology services were close runner-ups with non face-toface rates of over 90%.


