Your Contribution

Taken together, ARMC, the Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP),and Riverside University Health System (RUHS) have processed **39,819 eConsults** to date.

ARMC primary care clinics are kicking off the new year on the right foot, having processed 1,454 eConsults this month alone, and **12,393** eConsults total.

By coordinating with **52** specialist reviewers across **31** specialties via eConsult, **155** providers at **7** ARMC clinic sites succeeded in resolving many cases without the need for an in-person visit.



One third of all plastic surgery eConsults for Plastic Surgery were settled by entirely virtual means this month. Wound Care services came in second.
