Your Contribution

Taken together, RUHS, the Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP), and Arrowhead Regional Medical Center (ARMC) have processed **39,819 eConsults** to date.

RUHS primary care clinics are kicking off the new year on the right foot, having processed 1,452 eConsults this month alone, and **13,532** eConsults total.

By coordinating with **34** specialist reviewers across **16** specialties via eConsult, **116** providers at **19** RUHS clinic sites succeeded in resolving many cases without the need for an in-person visit in January.



About one third of all eConsults for endocrinology and hepatology services were settled by entirely virtual means this month!
